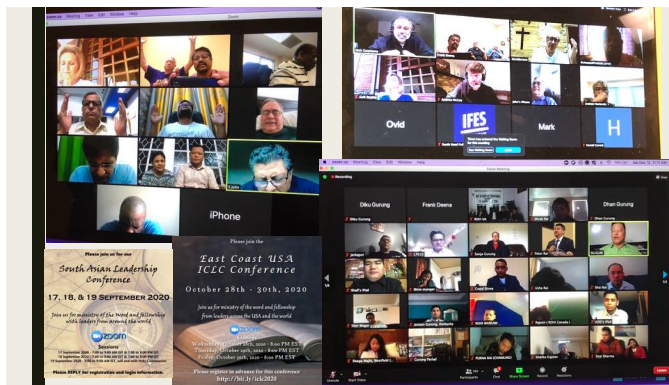

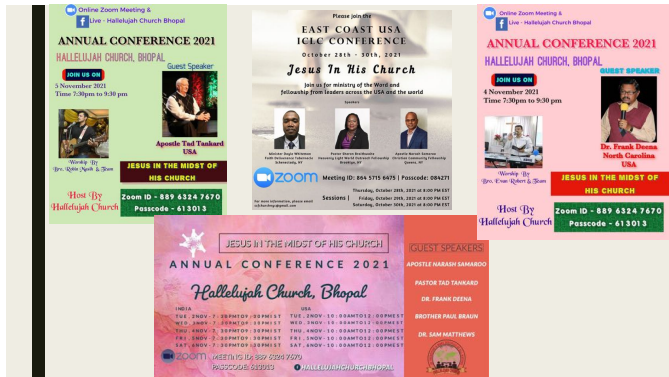
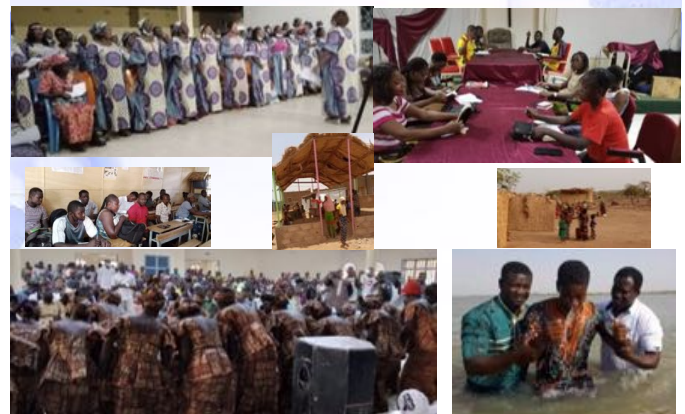

DR. ERNIE CAMPE: After 24 years in business, Ernie was able to fulfill a life-long dream of attending seminary.
